* Top 2 teams of group A and group B are qualified for finals.

Phase III :

There are five rounds in finals.

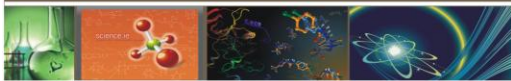
1st round - Passing the question (A to D)
