



“Eradicate caste system to protect human rights”

“Eradicate caste system to protect human rights”, said Justice, S.R. Nayak, Chairperson, Karnataka State Human Rights Commission, Bangalore. He spoke in a National Seminar on “Promotion and Protection of Human Rights” organized by K.L.E. Society’s P.C. Jabin Science College, Hubli.

He opined, “The root cause for violation and exploitation of human rights is caste system. So, eradicate it”. He referred to Vedas wherein there is a capsule of human rights –*Sarve Jana Sukhino Bhavantu*” (Welfare of all human beings). He hailed Buddha, Allamaprabhu and Basavanna, who practiced and preached humanity. “Women have a large role to play in building “Vishwa Manava” (Real human being), he emphasized.
